GUIDELINES FOR WJAS ANNUAL EXHIBITION - SORRENTO SURF LIFESAVING CLUB

2023 Exhibition Dates – Friday, September 1st to Sunday, September 3rd.

Entry open date: Monday, July 17th - Entry close date: Monday, August 7th

ENTRY

- You must be a Financial WJAS Member to Enter
- Entry forms and fees must be submitted before the closing date. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Entry Forms cannot be changed after submission.
- \$20 Entry Fee 20% Commission on Sales.

ROSTER

- All Exhibiting Artists must commit to at least two roster shifts manning the Exhibition.
- You cannot enter any Artwork if you cannot commit to at least two roster shifts.
- If you cannot commit to two Roster shifts for any reason, you must request permission from the WJAS Secretary to be exempt <u>before</u> submitting your Entry Form.
- You can request permission to have a friend or family member do the two Roster shifts on your behalf.

PRESENTATION OF ARTWORKS

- Artworks must be presented to a high standard.
- Canvases, Frames & Glass must be CLEAN without <u>any</u> damage.
- Artworks that do not meet WJAS standards or are oversize will not be accepted at delivery.
- Artworks must be labelled on the back with the Title and Artists Name.

ARTWORKS ORIGINALITY

- Artworks must be the original work of the Artist's own conception.
- · Copies of another Artist's work are not eligible for entry.
- Copies of photographs from books, magazines or the Internet are not eligible for entry unless deemed Royalty Free.
- Artworks can be from a photograph if taken by the Artist or with permission of the photographer in writing.
- Artworks that have been exhibited in a WJAS Exhibition within the last two years are not eligible for entry.

ARTWORK SIZES

The size is measured by the <u>dimensions of the sides</u>, not the area. The size includes the frame. There are four Entry Categories with different size options – You choose to enter <u>ONE</u> Category Only.

- Category 1 3 x SMALL artworks SMALL = up to 60cm x 60cm including frame
- Category 2 2 x LARGE artworks LARGE = up to 110cm x 110cm including frame

- Category 3 1 x EXTRA LARGE artwork X LARGE = up to 120cm x 180cm including frame
- Category 4 1 x Sculpture+ 1 x LARGE artwork The Plinth provided by the Artist must be sturdy and have a footprint of less than 100cm x 100cm.

DIPTYCHS, TRIPTYCHS, SETS AND PAIRS

 Diptychs and Triptychs are one Artwork painted on two or three panels to form one image when hung together – they count as <u>one artwork</u>. A Diptych or Triptych must fit within the maximum dimensions.



 A Pair or Set are two or three artworks that match or complement each other when hung together they count <u>as two or three artworks</u>.



Each artwork in a Set must be equal to or less than the maximum dimensions.

FRAMING

- Artworks must be suitably framed with secure hanging equipment.
- Stretched canvases can be unframed but must have a suitably finished edge with no side staples or screws.
- Frames, mat boards, and glass must be clean and in good condition without scratches or any damage.
- It is preferred if 'd-rings' and cord are used see the example below. Eyelets only to be used on canvas where they can be recessed into the side of the frame Not protruding from the frame See examples below.
- Use the correct thickness of the cord and 'd-rings' for the size and weight of the artwork.
- Attach a D-ring no more than a 1/3 down from the top of the artwork or 10 cm down from the top of the artwork The artwork hangs better on the wall.
- Photo frames with metal hanging clasps are unsuitable and will not be accepted. Seal the back of Framed Artwork with suitable tape do not use cello, surgical, or masking tape.
